# SPECTACULAT NEPAL

## Day 01

**Arrival in Kathmandu  
(1400m)**

Upon arrival, you'll be met by a Motorcycle Expeditions representative and transferred to the hotel in a private vehicle. Dinner and overnight stay at a hotel.

## Day 02

**Kathmandu sightseeing  
(1400m)**

We'll spend the day sightseeing around Kathmandu, Boudhanath, Pashupatinath and Monkey Temple are the highlights. You'll be enjoying a traditional Nepalese dinner as a "Welcome to Nepal". Overnight stay at a hotel.

## Day 03

**Kathmandu to Nuwakot  
(1022m, 80km, 3hrs)**

After breakfast, we negotiate the traffic out of Kathmandu, towards Nuwakot. The verdant, sub-tropical Himalayan Mountains are a beautiful backdrop as we ride through the countryside of Nepal. After lunch at the hotel, a short stroll to visit the fabulous architecture of an impressive Nepalese village. Dinner and overnight stay at a hotel.

## Day 04

**Nuwakot to Bandipur  
(1030m, 140km, 5-6hrs)**

Bandipur, our destination for today, can be likened to the Tuscany of Nepal, showcasing its beautiful traditional Newari architecture. Along the way, we'll stop for lunch. Time permitting, you could take a lovely afternoon stroll to explore the beauty of Bandipur and its stunning views. Dinner and overnight stay at a hotel.

## Day 05

**Bandipur to Lake Begnas  
(650m, 70km, 4hrs)**

Unseen Nepal is beckoning today. Backroads and exquisite scenery will take us to Lake Begnas. Since we'll arrive early enough, you can spend the afternoon taking in the peace of Lake Begnas. Dinner and overnight stay at a hotel.

## Day 06

**Lake Begnas to Kalopani  
(2300m, 140km, 5-6hrs)**

On our way to Sarankot, if the skies are clear, we'll be afforded a fantastic view of the mighty Fishtail Mountain right from our handlebars. Have your cameras ready as we'll be crossing the longest and highest suspension bridge in Nepal to get to the other side of the valley. Dinner and overnight stay at a guest house.

## Day 07

**Kalopani to Muktinath  
(3800m, 50km, 4-5hrs)**

We're in for a day through some of the most amazing landscapes of the Kali Gandai River, tackling a large river crossing in Lower Mustang while surrounded by gigantic mountains. Dinner and overnight stay at a guest house.

## Day 08

**Muktinath to Pokhara  
(1400m, 178km, 7-8hrs)**

An early morning departure is recommended as this will be the longest day in the saddle on this tour. There will be enough stops along the way to catch our breath and appreciate the mind-blowing scenery. Since Pokhara is such a vibrant town, we'll be exploring a bit of nightlife around dinner time. Overnight stay at a hotel.

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## Day 09

**Pokhara at leisure  
(1400m)**

Pokhara is a beautiful, modern, buzzing town surrounded by high Himalayan snowcapped mountains overlooking Fewa Lake. A stroll around the Lake is highly recommended. Activities such as paragliding, bungee jumping, zip flying, and ultra-light flights are optional and must be booked directly by the clients. Dinner and overnight stay at a hotel.

## Day 10

**Pokhara to Chitwan  
(415m, 170km, 5-6hrs)**

Another adventure awaits! The highway from Pokhara to Kathmandu/Chitwan will be busy and possibly dusty due to ongoing roadwork. Upon arrival, check into the hotel and enjoy a quick lunch. Later in the afternoon, we'll head out for a canoeing trip, which is included as part of the tour package, to explore sections of the surrounding jungle. In the evening, relax with a drink and enjoy the stunning sunset over Chitwan National Park. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

\* Due to the immense cruelty involved in elephant rides, we don't recommend elephant safaris to any of our riders/participants.

## Day 11

**Chitwan to Kathmandu  
(1400m, 180km, 5-6hrs)**

Relax and relish the thrill—you've conquered an epic Nepalese motorcycle adventure! Today, we ride back to Kathmandu, where part of the road will be busy. Once we reach the city's outskirts, we'll switch to a minibus for the final leg to our hotel. On our last evening together, we'll enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant, bidding goodbye to the team and celebrating our journey. Overnight stay at a hotel.

## Day 12

**Kathmandu to airport  
drop.**

You did it! The adventure has ended, and we hope you've created unforgettable memories with us. Your airport transfer will be arranged according to your flight schedule. Please arrive 3 hours early to avoid any last-minute rush. It was fantastic having you all with us—safe travels!

## What your tour includes

- Transfer from Tribhuvan International Airport to Kathmandu at the beginning of your trip, and transfer from Kathmandu to Tribhuvan International Airport at the conclusion
- Sightseeing (including the transport) for a day in Kathmandu and a welcome dinner
- A Royal Enfield Himalayan 450cc motorbike for the duration of your trip
- Petrol (for the bikes and support vehicles for the trip)
- Experienced, English-speaking mechanics and guides
- Support vehicle carrying spare bike parts, gas, tools, mineral water, snacks and rider luggage
- Accommodation (among the best in-area hotels and guest houses)
- All meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner, mineral water and snacks on the way)
- Basic first-aid kit with medicine for altitude
- Annapurna Conservation Area Permit (ACAP) and Trekkers Information Management System (TIMS)

## Excluded

- International flights
- Nepal entry visa
- Travel insurance - you must organise this before you leave home. Make sure it covers you for moto touring on the size bike you will ride and covers medical evacuation, medical bills, and repatriation
- International motorcycle license (international driving permit)
- Motorcycle damage - you are liable for all damage to your bike on the trip
- All alcohol and any extra drinks you may order. We ask that you settle your extra drinks and alcohol bill each day before you leave, directly with the accommodation
- Tips and gratuities (suggested at US\$ 100-)
- Riding gear including helmet, boots, gloves, etc
- Accommodation, meals, and any attractions NOT included in the tour (includes any pre and post-tour extra accommodation, travel to and from the starting points)
- Costs incurred or expenses arising due to natural calamities, strikes, breakdowns and any other unforeseen calamities beyond the control of Mo Ex Motorcycle Expeditions GmbH and its associates (force majeure)

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## Booking confirmation requirements

- Each person must fill in a Rider Registration Form
- Every individual must review, understand, and provide a signature acknowledging the Agreement and the Terms and Conditions
- Payment of the booking fee
  - A USD 500.00 deposit per person is payable to Motorcycle Expeditions at the time of booking (Motorcycle Expeditions does NOT cover bank transfer fees of payments made)
  - The entire balance payment is due 2 calendar months before the start date of the tour.

Booking will ONLY be secured after fulfilling all the 3 terms above

## Cancellation fees

- For Cancellation received more than 60 days before the trip departure date — 10% of the total price is charged
- For Cancellation received 31–60 days before the trip departure date — 25% of the total price is charged
- For Cancellation received 16–30 days before the trip departure date — 50% of the total price is charged
- For Cancellation received 0–15 days before the trip departure date — 100% of the total price is charged
- Cancellations will only be accepted in written form, via email.

## Mandatory requirements for going on a Tour

- Each person shall carry a valid passport with an expiration date of 6 months after the commencement date of the tour
- An entry visa into Nepal
- An unrestricted, valid motorcycle license (A1/A)
- A valid international driving permit (driving license)
- Travel insurance must encompass moto touring for the specific bike capacity ridden on the tour. It should cover tour cancellations, medical expenses, emergency evacuation, repatriation, and adventure sports during the tour
- Protective motorcycle gear (helmet, gloves, jacket, pants and boots)
